



## **ALL-STATE JAZZ WIND AUDITION PROCEDURES FOR 2010**

1. There will be prelim rooms open at 9:00 a.m. All of the prelim auditions will be done separately.
2. As the prelims in each room complete, we will post the callbacks on the glass wall in the Commons at Hickman High School. All students will need to report to the appropriate callback room ASAP.
3. The Call-Back Rooms will begin auditioning the players as soon as the call backs are posted. Please encourage your students to get to the rooms, so the judges are not waiting and we can keep the process moving.
4. Students will play all or part of the prepared material. Sight-reading may be required, so be prepared. All judges have the option of requiring this in an audition.
5. Once the final call-backs are finished, the students that have finished at the top may be called in to the office to determine what instrument and/or band they would like to participate in. They will have their name called twice, and if they don't report within a short amount of time, a coin toss will be used to determine his or her placement. In past years, a considerable amount of time has been wasted looking for these students.

Additional Notes: Directors-please advise your students to proceed to their Prelim Room in a timely fashion beginning at 9:00 a.m. Also, advise them to be available in the commons area to check those call-back lists early and get to the call back rooms asap.
